Bike Racks are available on all Route 90 (Miller Park) trips. Each rack holds two bikes and use is free with applicable fare



Route 90 (Miller Park) begins at the Downtown Transit Center and makes stops along Wisconsin Avenue. From N. Van Buren St to N. 10th St, stops are made roughly every two blocks. After N. 10th St, Route 90 stops about every four blocks up to N. 38th St. Route 90 drops off passengers at the MCTS Transit Area on Yount Drive on the north side of Miller Park. Return trips operate from Yount Drive along Wisconsin Avenue to the Downtown Transit Center. MCTS Transfer Connections to Miller Park chart gives detailed Transfer Connections between MCTS Routes and other Intermodal Transportation options. Route 10 (Humboldt-Wisconsin)* & Route 18 (National-Greenfield)* also provide service to Miller Park that stop within walking distance of Miller Park.
