Greyhound Bus Terminal (Downtown Chicago)

Located at Harrison and Jefferson.
From the Blue Line subway, exit at Clinton. Walk one block south on Clinton and one block west on Harrison.

Buses 7 (Harrison), 36 (Broadway), 60 (Blue Island/26th) operates to Greyhound Terminal daily, with Route 36 (Broadway) operating to terminal after 10:30 pm until 12:30 pm daily

Buses 125 (Water Tower Express), 156 (LaSalle), 157 (Streeterville/Taylor) operates to Greyhound terminal during weekdays only, with Route 125 (Water Tower Express) operating during rush periods only



Greyhound Bus Terminal (Downtown Milwaukee)

Located at N. 5th & W. St. Paul Ave

Bus Route 57 (Walnut-92nd) terminates in front of the Milwaukee Intermodal Station daily, Route 80 (6th Street) operates daily and makes a stop at 6th & Clybourn, Walk one block east to 5th, one block south to St. Paul.

Route 143 (Ozaukee County Express) has a convenient morning trip that goes directly to the station and an evening return trip that goes directly to the station.
