Looking forward to watching the boys of summer, but not dealing with stadium traffic? The Milwaukee County Transit System is the perfect way to get to Milwaukee Brewers baseball this season. For the Home Opener on April 6th 2012, **Route 90** (Miller Park) will provide service every 10 minutes to select stops along Wisconsin Avenue. Service will begin two hours before the 3:10 pm start time, so fans can reach the stadium in plenty of time to see the Brew Crew take on the St. Louis Cardinals. For all other home games, service runs every 30 minutes. This brochure will give you detailed information about MCTS service to All Brewers Home Games. 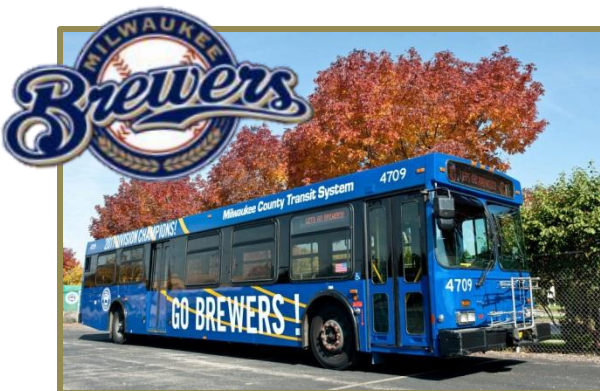

MCTS Transfer Connections to Miller Park

Route 90 (Miller Park) begins two hours before game time. On specific games when the Brewers project heavy attendance (e.g., Opening Day and Marquee Games), buses will operate every 10 minutes. During all other home games, buses will operate approximately every 30 minutes.

Alternative Service on Projected Heavy Attendance Games are available on **Route 10 (Humboldt-Wisconsin)**, **Route 23 (Fond Du Lac-National)** and **MetroExpress BlueLine (Fond Du Lac-National)** that stop within walking distance to Miller Park.

Bike Racks are available on all MCTS buses and are served on all **Route 90 (Miller Park)** trips. Each rack holds two bikes and use is free with applicable fare. Please see more information in MCTS Bikes on Buses Brochure or go to RideMCTS.com

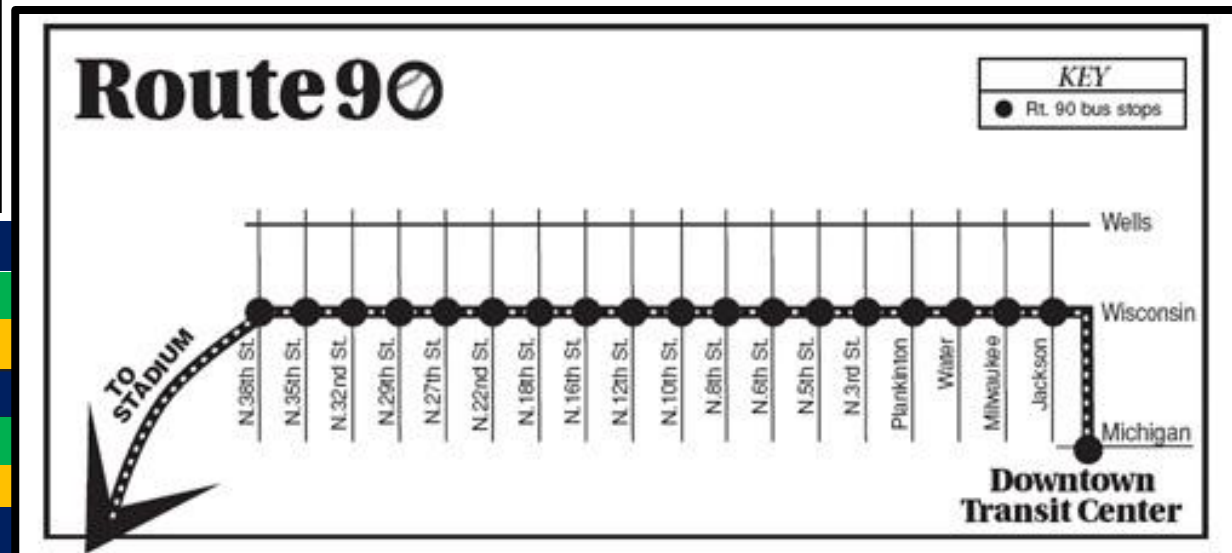

Route 90 (Miller Park) begins at the Downtown Transit Center and makes stops along Wisconsin Avenue. From N. Van Buren St to N. 10th St, stops are made roughly every two blocks with a detour between Broadway and 2nd St. (Detour information is detailed in this brochure, Please allow extra travel time). After N. 10th St, Route 90 stops about every four blocks up to N. 38th St. Route 90 drops off passengers at the MCTS Transit Area on Yount Drive on the north side of Miller Park. Return trips operate from Yount Drive along Wisconsin Avenue and detour routing to the Downtown Transit Center. MCTS Transfer Connections to Miller Park chart gives detailed Transfer Connections between other MCTS Routes including Transfer Connections along the detour.

Listed is a detailed chart of the **Milwaukee Brewers 2012 Home Game Dates, Visiting Teams, Game Start Times** and **MCTS Route 90 (Miller Park) Start Time of Operation** (all trips begin at Downtown Transit Center), which begins 2 hours before each Brewers home game every 30 minutes (**Specific games when Brewers project heavy attendance (e.g., Opening Day and Marquee Games), buses will operate every 10 minutes. This is denoted by the "Red Bold Text" highlighted**). **Route 90 (Miller Park)** service may vary due to games having delayed start times, extended innings or changes in Major League Baseball (MLB) Divisions Status (e.g., MLB Play Off Series) that may extend the season**. Route 90 (Miller Park) Wisconsin Avenue Detour

The Wisconsin Avenue Bridge is undergoing a long term construction project that will occur during the 2012 season. Customers are advised that buses are being detoured until further notice for the duration of the project, **so please allow extra travel time**. Routes affected are **Route 10** (Humboldt-Wisconsin), **Route 12** (Teutonia-Hampton), **Route 14** (Forest Home), **Route 30** (Sherman-Wisconsin), **Route 31** (State-Highland), **Route 40** (College-Ryan Flyer), **Route 43** (Whitnall Flyer), **Route 44** (National Flyer), **Route 46** (Loomis-Southridge Flyer), **Route 48** (South Shore Flyer), **Route 49** (Brown-Deer-Northshore Flyer)*, **Route 79** (Menomonee Falls Flyer), **Route 90** (Miller Park)**, **Route 137** (House of Corrections) and **Route 143** (Ozaukee County Express) †. **Eastbound** and **Westbound** trips are detoured between N. 2nd St and N. Broadway St. Bus Stops on the routes listed are moved from Wisconsin Ave to comparable stops along the detour. In order to reduce congestion, two separate detours are in place. Listed below are the detour maps and stop locations which **Route 90** (Miller Park) ** will serve. For more information about Route and Bus Stop locations along both detours, please visit RideMCTS.com or look for posted signs at bus stops between N. 2nd St and N. Broadway St.

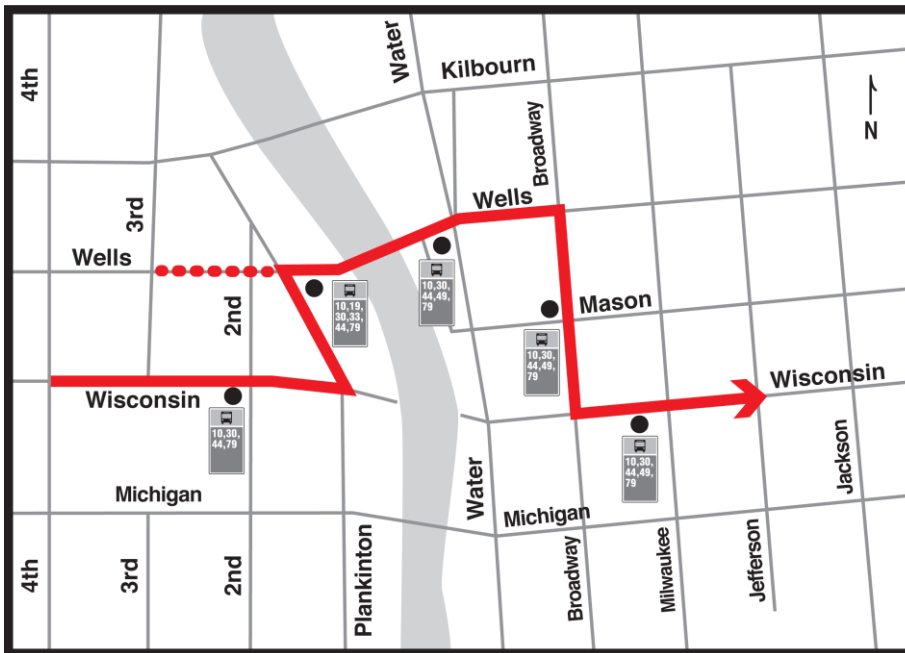

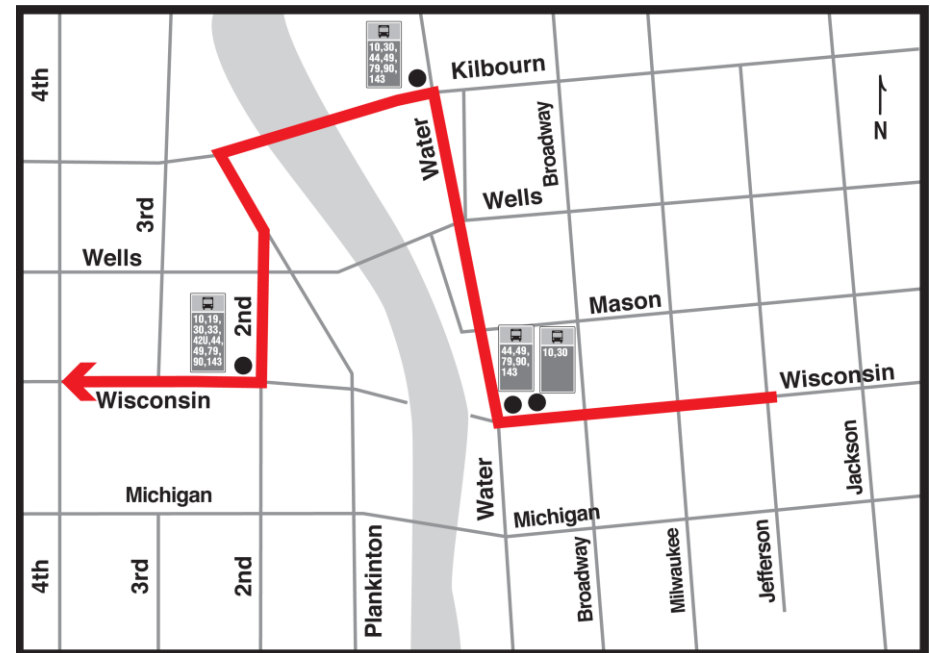
