CTA Announces Two Public Meetings on Red Line South Track Renewal Project

The Chicago Transit Authority today announced the dates for the first in a series of public meetings in advance of next year's Red Line South Track Renewal Project. CTA officials will explain the work, answer questions and receive feedback from customers who will be impacted by the project. This input will help CTA complete the project as effectively as possible. "It's very important to us to have a dialogue with the community about our plans to improve the Dan Ryan branch of the Red Line," said Terry Peterson, Chairman of the Chicago Transit Board. "We want them to know that we are doing everything in our power to make their travel as smooth as possible during the five-month project, and it's important for us to hear their thoughts about what we can do to further aid in that process."
