There is a lot to maintaining 11 ton vehicles. Learn the details of how this is done by visiting the Fleet Maintenance Building. Very rarely do we provide tours, but we will be proud to show an inside look at Mechanical Repair where mechanics repair or replace major bus components like engines, transmissions, air-conditioning and brakes. Also, we will look at Body Repair where mechanics repair the outside of the bus from major reworking of frames, dents to body corrosion. We will learn how they paint buses in large spray booths which look like something NASA would use. Specific tour times **11:30; 1:30 and 3:30 and last one hour**. One of the New Clean-Diesel buses with Near-Zero Emissions will be on display to view at any time from **11:00 A.M. to 5:00 P.M.**
